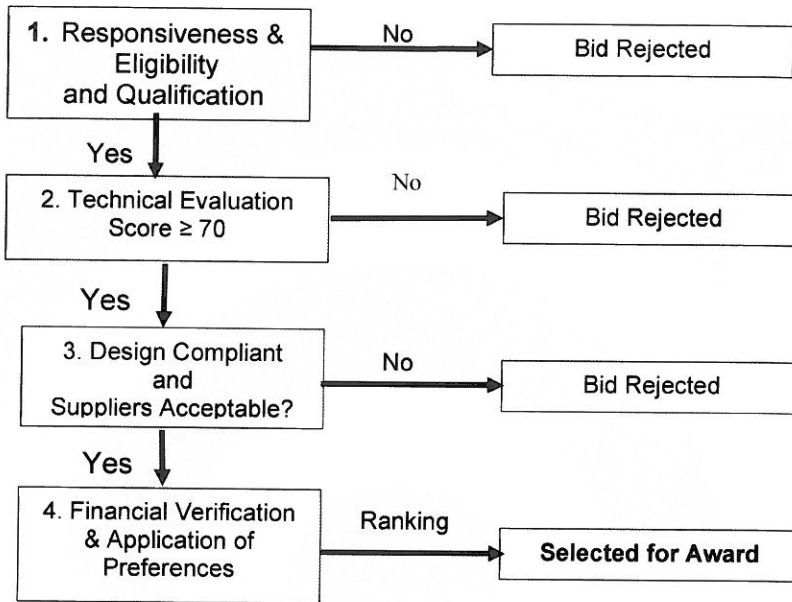

The total value of the contract was **N\$ 340,808,287.38** (Three Hundred and forty Million Eight Hundred and Eight Thousand Two Hundred and Eighty-Seven Namibian Dollars and Thirty-Eight Cents).
