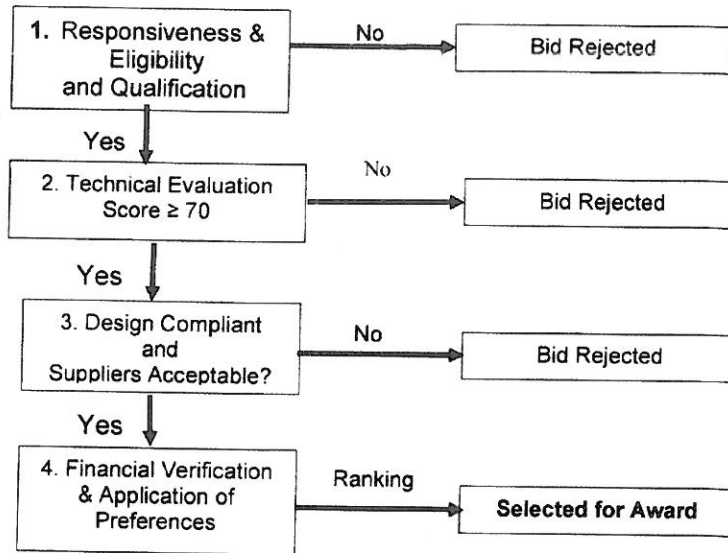

With only one bidder fully compliant to all stages, the bidder's quoted rates were scrutinized, and no arithmetical errors were found. The total value of the contract was **N\$ 340,808,287.38** (Three Hundred and forty Million Eight Hundred and Eight Thousand Two Hundred and Eighty-Seven Namibian Dollars and Thirty-Eight Cents).

13. RECOMMENDATION FOR AWARD:

Sinohydro Cooperation Limited and Adaptive Building Land Construction CC be appointed for the Procurement of Design and Construction of Kunene and Omatando Substation, for **N\$340,808,287.38** (Three Hundred and forty Million Eight Hundred and Eight Thousand Two Hundred and Eighty-Seven Namibian Dollars and Thirty-Eight Cents)
