8. Bid Background and Evaluation Overview

The procurement activity was an Expression of interest for the shortlisting of consultants for the provision of technical advisory and project management services for the NamPower Otjikoto Biomass Power Station.

The successfully shortlisted Bidders would be invited to submit a detailed proposal during the next phase of the procurement activity which would be the Request for Proposal.

The evaluation was conducted based on the shortlisting criteria described in section I of the expression of interest document as follows:

- 1. Confirmation of the executed and submitted Expression of Interest Declaration and Undertaking
- 2. Confirmation of the commitment to enter into a joint venture (JV) agreement with a local Namibian Consultant(s) for execution and full duration of the services.
- 3. Confirmation of the commitment to ensure maximum skills and knowledge transfer to NamPower staff and a local Namibian Consultant.
- 4. Confirmation of commitment to reserve the set aside services for Namibians.
- 5. Submission of a company profile providing information of their staff, competencies and reference projects.
- 6. Submission of a method statement of the proposed methodology for skills and knowledge transfer.

The evidence for the evaluation criteria number (1) - (4) above were confirmed through a signed *Declaration and Undertaking Form* that was to be submitted by the interested Bidders. The BEC also evaluated whether Bidders complied with the following eligibility statement as indicated in the *Declaration and Undertaking Form*:

"As the Consultant, we acknowledge that we have not previously been involved in the compilation or review of the NamPower bidding documents, technical specifications and/or feasibility study for the Otjikoto Biomass Power Station and are thus eligible to participate".

Bidders who did not comply with the above statement were considered ineligible and their Bid was therefore deemed non-responsive.

9. Acceptance of Lead Consultant

The Expression of Interest document requested that potential consultants indicate their commitment to form a Joint venture in future between a local Namibian consulting firm and an international consulting firm. There was however no requirement to enter into a joint venture during the Expression of Interest phase. In the case where a Bid was submitted as joint venture, the BEC accepted the lead consultant to be the company(s) which signed the Declaration and Undertaking Form.
